DONATES OVER \$10,000 TO LOCAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTERS AND AWARENESS ORGANIZATIONS

MURRAY, UT - Cameo College of Essential Beauty donated a total of \$10,137.95 to two Utah domestic violence shelters and “Cut It Out”, a national domestic violence awareness organization, on Tuesday, December 9th.

The money was raised at a recent Hair Show Competition put on by the college. Students competed by transforming their show models into well-known celebrities through hair, makeup and costume. More than 1,000 attended the show at Murray High School.

Ten percent of the donated money will go to educational materials for “Cut It Out”, a national domestic violence awareness program that teaches salon professionals the warning signs of domestic violence and how to safely refer clients to local help. The remaining will be split between two local domestic violence shelters.

“We have students and staff that have been a part of this program which has helped them in their time of need. We don't realize the huge problem that is in our so-called homes today where we are suppose to feel safe,” said Brenda Scharman, owner of Cameo College of Essential Beauty.
